## New Features

### Integration of the Netop TeachPad

We have integrated our popular Netop TeachPad with the release of Netop School version 6.2. The TeachPad allows access to the essential features of School without the need to perform multiple precise mouse clicks; freeing teachers up from their seats and allowing them to maintain rapport with their students during lab classes. The TeachPad has five easy to use buttons and simply connects to the USB port on your teacher's computer:-

- My Classroom button: acts as a toggle button allowing the teacher to quickly and easily switch between their desktop and Netop School's Thumbnail view allowing instant supervision of the classroom at a glance without the need to sit at their computer and perform precise mouse clicks. At the same time student computers are "re-joined" to ensuring smooth connectivity

Assuming that the teacher module is already launched:-

- Demo button: the Demo button allows the teacher to quickly and easily Demo their whole screen to all computers in the current classroom and then switch back to their desktop repeatedly and with ease
- Blank button: allows the teacher to quickly and easily Blank their screen on all computers in the current classroom, pressed once more the students can pick-up where they left off their lab work
- Lock Web / Surf-Lock button: allows the teacher to quickly and easily stop use of the internet on all computers in the current classroom. Then, when pressed a second time the "Reset Policy" command reapplies any default policy
- Stop button: allows the teacher to quickly and easily stop any Demo, whether previously started in the Teacher Module or from the TeachPad itself;

## Bug Fixes

### Problem with answers to multiple-answer questions on Windows 7

When sending the Netop School sample test to student computers on Windows 7, the multiple choice question didn't function properly in that when a student selected a wrong answer and then tried to change it they could not. The defect has been fixed.

## **Nap64.exe crash after applying a "deny web" policy**

When a customer applied a "deny web" policy (or any other web policy), napx64.exe crashed and after that policies were no longer effective anymore. The defect manifested on Windows 7 Enterprise / 64-bit computers with Intel Xeon E5205, 8GB RAM and Nvidia Quadro FX 1700, antivirus engine was Microsoft Forefront. The defect has been fixed.

## **Crash on student module while opening resources in tests.**

After a teacher created a test with attached to the questions resources such as; images, xls files, doc files, pdf files and sent them to the student for evaluation, the student would get a notification that the resources were not accessible from student computer when trying to access them. The defect has been fixed.

## **Student module deployment failed on Windows XP**

When performing the deployment of the student module, as a teacher, from the teacher module, the deployment failed with the following error in the log: LAB01 (AddConnection failed with code 1326 : Logon failure: unknown user name or bad password.). The problem manifested in a context where all computers were Windows XP, part of the same workgroup and local Administrator's password was the same on all computers. The defect has been fixed.

## Known Issues

### **IE8 crash with NBHO.dll plugin**

IE8 crashes with NBHO.dll each time it is opened with add-ons activated.

Workaround1: restart IE8 a few times

Workaround2: disable all add-ons and start IE8 with only NBHO active

### **Web policy of type "block all except one site" doesn't work**

On a Windows XP with SP3, when the teacher creates a policy of type "block all sites except one single site", all the sites are including the one that should have been the exception.
